Job Summary

Cleaning designated areas of the school in accordance with Trust cleaning specifications and to ensure these are kept in a clean and hygienic condition on a daily basis as instructed by the Head Teacher.

Duties and Responsibilities

Main Duties include but are not limited to:

- To clean designated areas of the school as allocated by the Head Teacher. These areas may be changed, depending on the needs of the school.
- Cleaning, washing, sweeping, vacuum cleaning in a variety of teaching areas. Cleaning of public areas, corridors, etc. children's and staff toilets.
- Polishing and dusting of fixtures and fittings.
Where appropriate, after instruction, use of powered equipment.
- To follow Health and Safety codes. Health and Hygiene code of practice in relation to cleaning, e.g. C.O.S.H.H, siting of warning cones, etc.
- To report faulty equipment to the Premises Manager as necessary.
- Any other cleaning duties as directed by the Head Teacher.
- A willingness to undergo training as and when required for the job.
- Be reliable and trustworthy.
